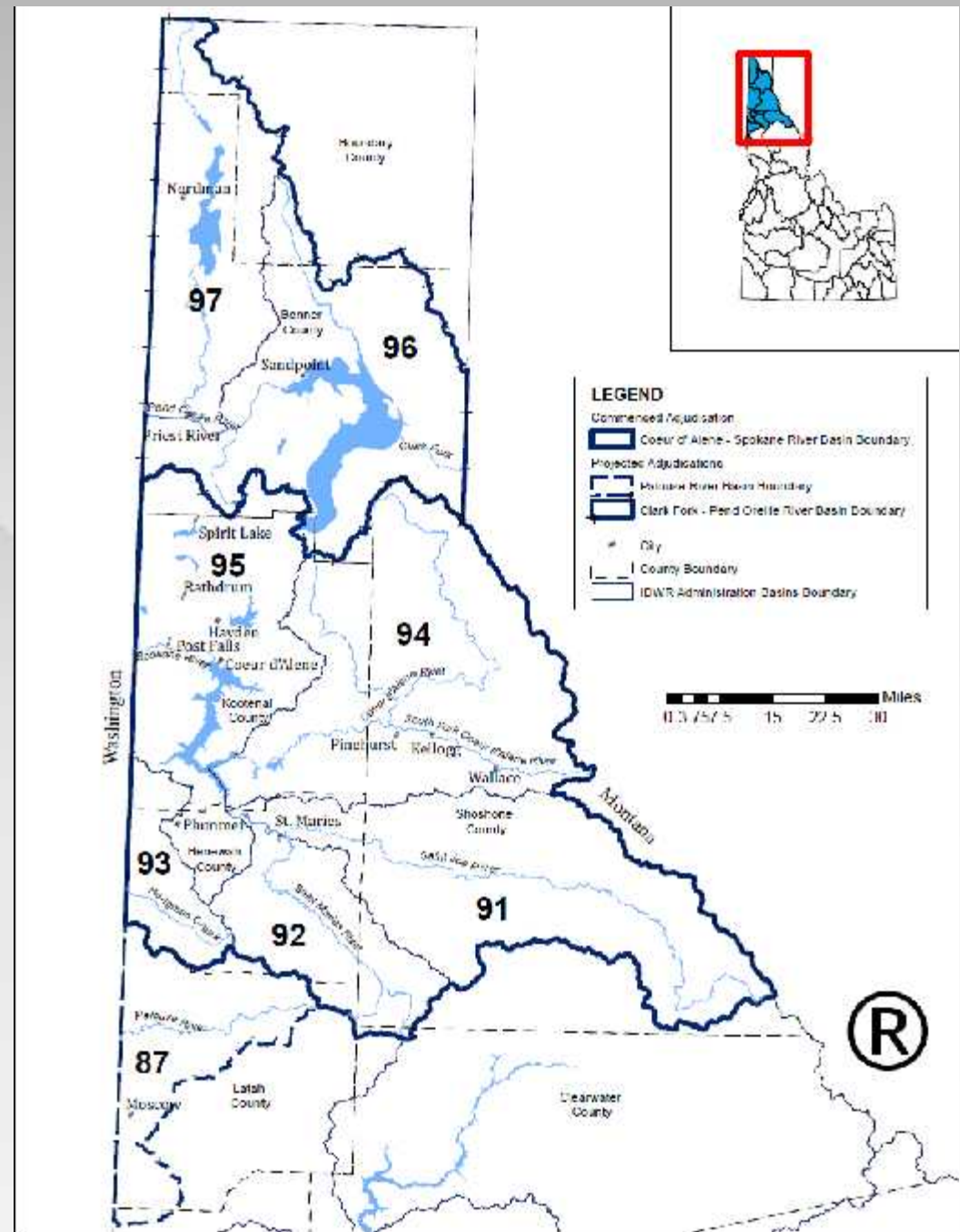

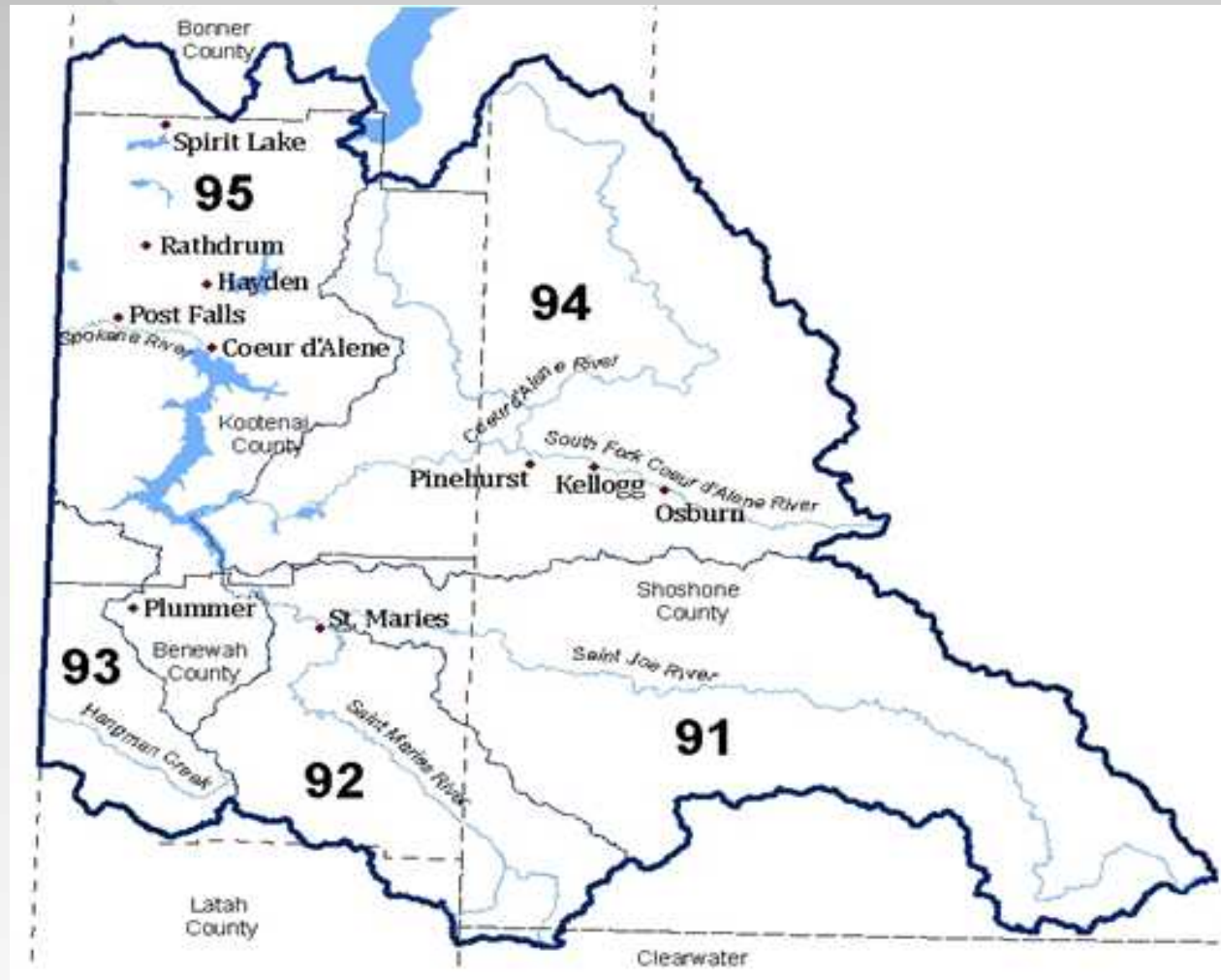

Coeur d'Alene-Spokane River Basin Adjudication

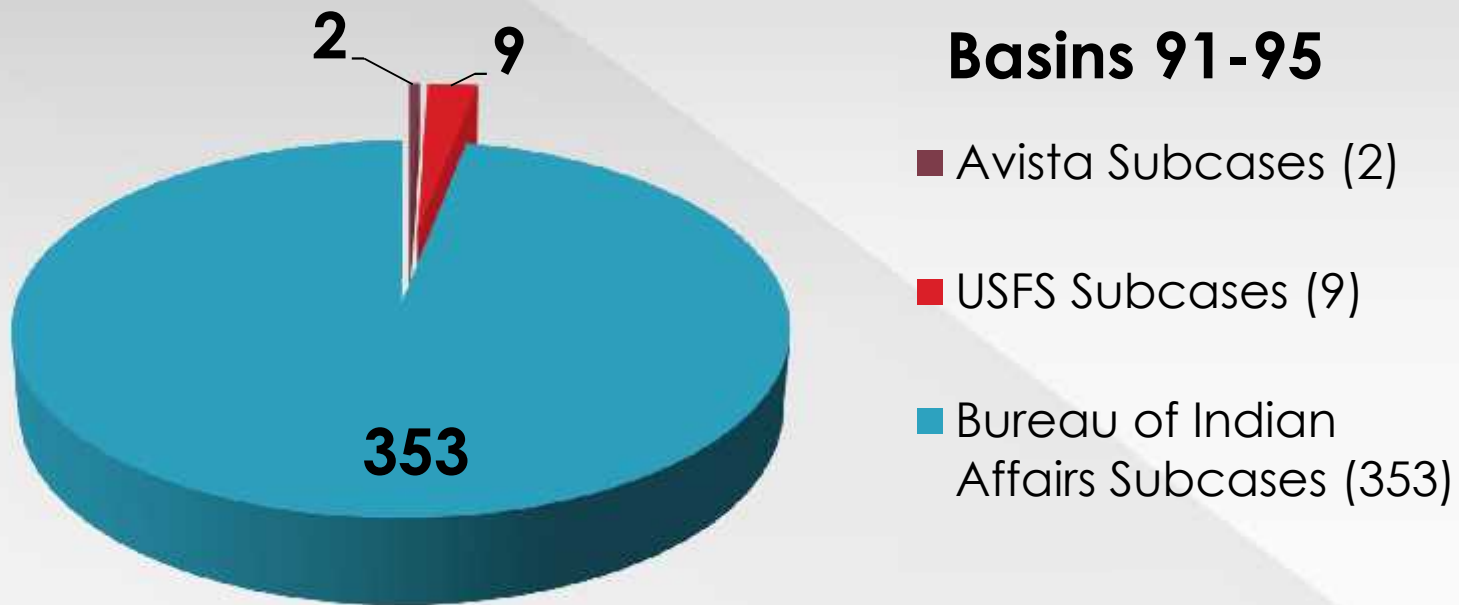

- Objection Deadline – September 2014
 - > 2 objections
- Uncontested Hearing – December 2014

Basin 92

- Objection Deadline – May 2015
 - > 114 Objections in 59 Contested Subcases
 - Forest Practices
 - Quantity
 - Priority Date
 - Trespass/Encroachment
- Uncontested Hearing – September 2015

Basin 91

- Objection Deadline – June 2015
 - > 66 Objections in 46 Contested Subcases
 - Forest Practices
 - Quantity
 - Priority Date
 - Trespass/Encroachment

- Uncontested Hearing – October 2015

Basin Wide Issue – 1

- “What information must be included in the Quantification of de minimis domestic and stockwater decrees?”
- Court found Director’s Reports satisfy statutory obligations.

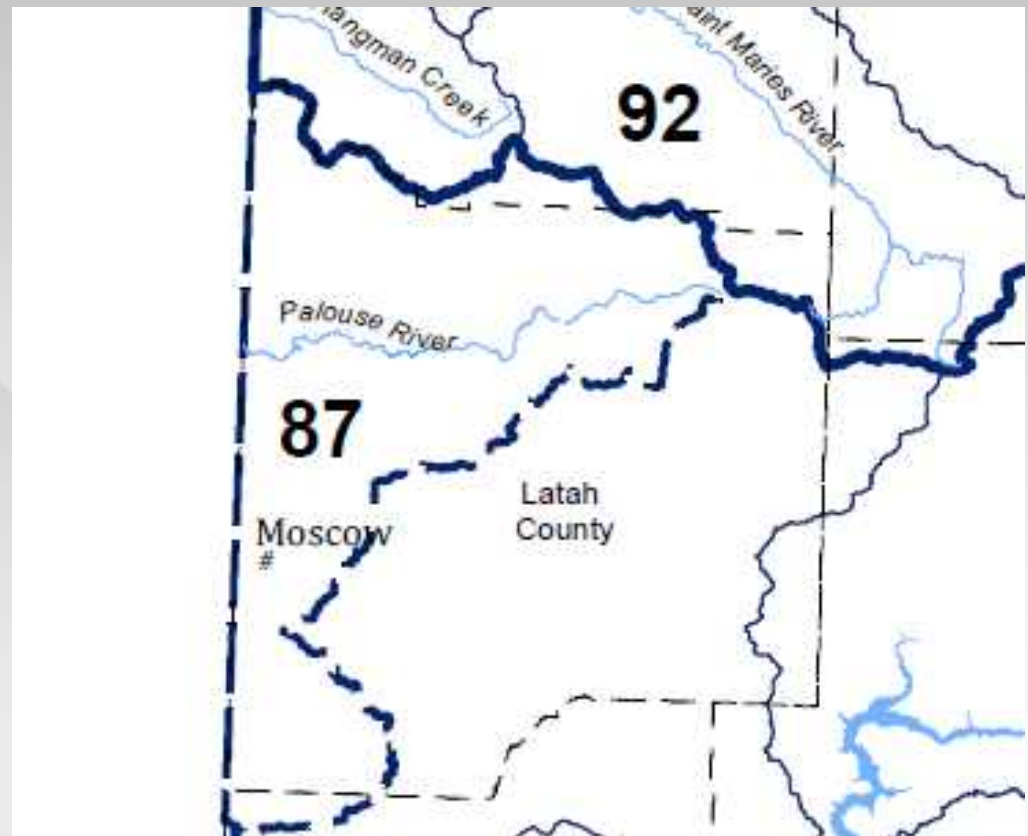
Basin 94
