What's New in the Report

- Discussion of improvement since 70's
- TMDL goals (allocations)
- Nonpoint sources
 - Forest road requirements & information from IEP
 - Information from the updated tracking database
 - ~195 projects
 - 50 agricultural crop BMPs (direct seed, etc)
 - 15 stormwater projects
 - 81 riparian planting projects
 - 9 shoreline stabilization projects
 - 29 livestock fencing projects
 - Does not include reduction estimates.



What's New in the Report

- Avista
 - Include more information from their 2013 report
 - Summary of their data & graphs
- Point sources
 - Submitted information about their activities
 - Graphs of effluent data showing improvements
 - DMR data in an appendix



What's In the Report

- Monitoring
 - Included inflow, temperature & precipitation data
 - Talk about data in relation to chronology of actions
 - Trying to get data from the Idaho reach
