EnviroStars was started in the Puget Sound area in 1995, and now has participation by over 700 businesses in western Washington. In early 2010, a partnership was formed to bring EnviroStars to Spokane.

Program administration and public recognition activities are conducted by the Spokane River Forum. Funding support and oversight are provided by the Spokane Aquifer Joint Board, City of Spokane Solid Waste Management Department, and Washington Department of Ecology. The Spokane Regional Health District provides Local Source Control pollution prevention technical assistance and EnviroStars certification visits.

What is EnviroStars?

EnviroStars is a voluntary program offered to local small businesses. The program certifies businesses that have practices and policies in place which demonstrate proper management and reduction of hazardous waste. A unique partnership between agencies and non-profits provides participants with public recognition and advertising.

Benefits of Becoming an EnviroStars Certified Business:

- ★ Show the community your commitment to the protection of the river, aquifer and our water quality.
- ★ Attract customers by being green – survey results show that 88% of consumers want the businesses they patronize to reduce their use of hazardous materials.
- ★ Gain access to EnviroStars.org business assistance resources.
- ★ Create a safer, healthier work environment.
- ★ Reduce regulatory burden.
- ★ Strengthen supplier and agency relationships.
- ★ Increase efficiency and save on disposal and material costs.
- ★ Advertising and promotion:

EnviroStars Program Requirements:

- ★ Generate only small quantities of hazardous waste. Typical businesses include auto body and repair shops, dentists, dry cleaners, print services, and small manufacturers.
- ★ Participate in a voluntary Local Source Control site visit with a Spokane Regional Health District representative to verify that you meet qualification standards.
- ★ Set a goal to improve practices and reduce hazardous materials/waste.
- ★ Renew EnviroStars certification annually.

Levels of Certification

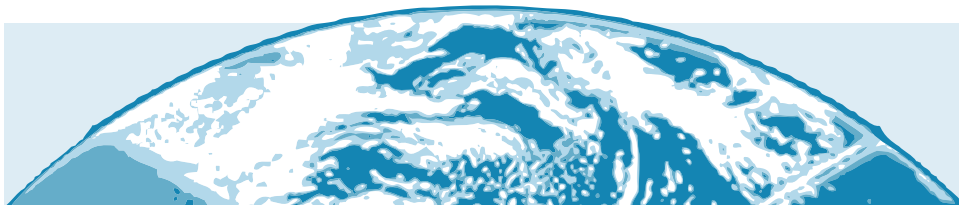
2-Star Certification – To earn 2-Star Certification all waste must be properly managed and a plan outlined for future waste reduction.

Contact EnviroStars Spokane for a certification visit. An onsite consultation, at no charge, will take you through a local source control checklist and EnviroStars application. When the requirements are met, your business will qualify for EnviroStars recognition.
