

Greater Spokane River Watershed Regional Partnership Program (GSRW RCPP)

Public Meetings

GSRW RCPP is a partner-driven, locally led approach to enhancing conservation efforts in the Spokane River Watershed. NRCS awarded \$7.7 million from the RCPP program to the Spokane Conservation District (SCD) and partners to help producers and private forest landowners enhance conservation efforts across nearly 4 million acres of the Spokane River Watershed in Eastern Washington and North Idaho.

Directions: Take U.S. 95 south past Plummer. Continue for another 13 miles to DeSmet. Take a right on DeSmet Road, then take the first left. Go past the Coeur d'Alene Tribal School. Then take a left on Byrne Road, go about four blocks and the new longhouse is on the right.

Directions: From Spokane take U.S. 2 north past the U.S. 395 interchange. Continue north on U.S. 2 for 2.4 miles past Mt. Spokane Park Dr. to E. Day Mt. Spokane Rd. Take a right on E. Day Mt Spokane Rd. This will turn into N. Day Mt. Spokane Rd. Continue east 3.8 miles to N. Dunn Rd. Take a right on Dunn Rd. Continue approximately ½ mile south to the intersection of E Dunn, E. Day Rd. & Applewood Ln. Turn right onto Applewood Ln. The Big Barn Brewing Co. meeting hall is immediately on your left. **Beer will be available for purchase.**
