**WHERE:** Nine Mile Recreation Area, 11226 W. Charles Road, Nine Mile Falls WA. [Click here](#) for map.

**WHAT TO BRING:** A life jacket (also called a PFD - personal flotation device), if you have one. This will help get you onto the water sooner.

#### WHAT IS PROVIDED:

Lots of equipment - canoes, sea kayaks, whitewater kayaks, inflatable kayaks, recreational kayaks and stand-up paddle boards (SUPs) - plus PFDs. Experienced paddlers will be there to help you get started.
