#### **IWAC PURPOSE**

WORK TOGETHER TO MAINTAIN AND/OR ENHANCE WATER QUALITY AND QUANTITY FOR PRESENT AND
FUTURE GENERATIONS BY <u>DEVELOPING MANAGEMENT STRATEGIES</u> WHICH BENEFIT THE SPOKANE VALLEY
RATHDRUM PRAIRIE AQUIFER AND THE SPOKANE RIVER REGION. IWAC <u>FACILITATES</u> REGIONAL DIALOGUES
AND STUDIES THAT RESULT IN RECOMMENDATIONS FOR POLICY DIRECTIONS AND SHARED STEWARDSHIP OF
THE AQUIFER AND THE SPOKANE RIVER, IN A COLLABORATIVE MANNER.

#### **IWAC GOALS**

THE OBJECTIVE OF DEVELOPING MANAGEMENT STRATEGIES IS TO <u>ADDRESS REGIONAL WATER SUPPLY AND</u>

 AWARENESS AND EDUCATION.




### ON THE GROUND INITIATIVES

## UPDATE OF THE 2007 USGS AQUIFER MODEL IN IDAHO

- MODEL WILL BE UPDATED USING MODFLOW-USG, A 3D NUMERICAL MODEL TO SIMULATE GROUNDWATER FLOW IN THE SVRPA
  - SAJB INITIATED AN UPDATE TO THE AQUIFER MODEL WEST OF THE STATE BOUNDARY IN WA
  - IWAC IS PROPOSING AN UPDATE TO THE AQUIFER MODEL EAST OF THE STATE BOUNDARY IN ID.
  - THE GOAL OF THE PROJECT IS TO HAVE BOTH MODELS FUNCTION INTERCHANGEABLY AS ONE MODEL
- PROPOSED UPDATES <u>INCLUDE</u>:
  - UPDATES TO MODEL LAYERING
  - INCORPORATION OF CLIMATE CHANGE AND FUTURE POPULATION GROWTH
  - EXTENSION OF THE MODEL DOMAIN INTO SPIRIT AND HOODOO VALLEYS
- THE UPDATE DOES NOT:
  - REPLACE THE EXISTING 2007 USGS MODEL PREVIOUSLY APPROVED BY STATE AND FEDERAL ENTITIES
  - UPDATE SVRPA BOUNDARIES
  - EVALUATE CONTAMINANT FATE AND TRANSPORT SCENARIOS
- CURRENT STATUS:
  - PHASE 1 IS PARTIALLY FUNDED BY THE KOOTENAI COUNTY AQUIFER PROTECTION DISTRICT
  - AN RFP IS DRAFTED
  - IWAC IS PLANNING A BI-STATE EDUCATIONAL OPPORTUNITY FOR WATER PURVEYORS AND POLITICAL STAKEHOLDERS
