  - 2,500 letters sent, every other year, to businesses that use toxic substances.
- Business Assistance
  - o EnviroCertified Business Certification Program
- Household Contaminant Disposal
  - Spokane Kootenai Waste and Recycle Directory
- Wellhead Protection Education and Awareness
  - o Research, studies, aquifer modelling, litigation, and protecting water rights
  - Water Quality Reports (Consumer Confidence Reports) posted on website
  - o 60 Aquifer Education Workshops and 30+ Community & School Events Annually
  - Media Campaigns to educate area residents and businesses
- SAJB collaborates with SRF, IWAC, KSPS PBS, DOH, SRHD, Ecology, Spokane County Solid Waste, Water Resources Aquifer Protection Area, Spokane Regional Clean Air Agency, City of Spokane, Weather Service, and others.
