- Transportation, Parks, Public Participation







- Washington Department of Commerce Grant
 - \$1.2M (Through 6/2025)
– Accepted 5/2024
 - GMA Climate Change and Resilience Element
 - Shared project/funding with County communities including Cheney, Millwood, Deer Park, Spangle, Rockford, Fairfield, Waverly, Latah



Climate and Resilience Planning

Greenhouse Gas Reduction Sub-element

- Project Initiation - Public/Tribal engagement and visioning
- Data Gathering / Technology Review – Collect emission data
- Evaluate Data and Sources – develop travel market assessments
- Establish Actions and Targets



Climate and Resilience Planning

Climate Resilience Sub-element

- Project Initiation - Public/Tribal engagement and visioning
- Consultant selection

- Data Gathering / Research – explore climate impacts
 - Pair assets/hazards and describe exposure and consequences

- Evaluate / Assess Vulnerability and Risk
 - Prepare vulnerability and risk assessment for the County

- Establish Goals and Policies with the Department of Emergency Mgt.
